The Godwit Days Spring Migration Bird Festival has been a Humboldt County fixture since 1996, started by the City of Arcata to promote ecotourism. The event was named after the Marbled Godwit, a large, attractive shorebird that gathers in the tens of thousands in Humboldt Bay during spring migration. In 2005, the nonprofit organization Godwit Days took over operations, adding a goal to educate the public about birds, habitat conservation, and ecology. This year, Godwit Days is staging a partial comeback, April 15th-17th, by offering 23 small-group, in-person field trips and 4 virtual sessions over 3 days. Godwit Days seeks financial help to rebuild the festival and continue to offer a low-cost eco-learning event featuring Humboldt's awesome field trip leaders, wide-ranging habitats, and incredible birds.
